Philipians 4:4-7

4 Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice!

5 Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near.

6 Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.

7 And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

Instructions: Print and place cards face up on table and let each person choose a card to read. Ask the questions giving everyone an opportunity to answer. Give freedom to “pass” on any question.

- 1. What does this particular passage (Philipians 4:4-7) call you to do? (Name as many as you see.)**
- 2. Why is the first part of Verse 4 repeated? Do you ever repeat things? Why?**
- 3. Why should we let our “gentleness be known to all”? Who is all?**
- 4. Share and tell each other specifics of when the Lord has been near during this quarantine time.**
- 5. Share ways you can use prayer and petition and thanksgiving to not be anxious.**
- 6. What does the verse actually mean? (Discuss interpretations.)**
- 7. How can this passage (especially verse 7) bring restoration and encouragement to another hurting soul?**
